## 4. Webinar participation 43%

About 700 NEBEOP postgraduates and teachers are now in our database. About two hundred of them follow the live webinars (29%) (3), while another hundred watch the recordings (14%) (12). That means that 57% of the NEBEOP postgraduates and teachers are still missing the unique opportunity to enhance their learning and teaching (2).
